



☆Filing of the City・Prefectural Residential Tax☆

Residents of the City as at January 1st, 2018 and those who receive documents on filing of taxes need to forward filing of the City and Prefectural Residential Tax.

<Do not Need to File>

- Employee with income payment reported by the place of employment.
- Those who have filed their Final Income Tax Return.
- Those living in the City without income, and spouse of them.
However, the following must file their Income Tax Return:
- Members of National Health Insurance (without income)
- Only Public Pension receivers with deductions of medical expenses, spouses, dependents and others.

<What to bring along>

- Filing Guidance Postcard (Receiver)
- Personal Seal
- My Number Identification Card
- Income Tax Return of 2017
- National Health Insurance Tax/Nursery care premium/National Pension certification/the Old-Old Medical Insurance Certification.
- Life insurance or Earthquake premium and certification on damage for long term at Dec 31, 2006.
- Certification for disabled allowance and disability handbook.
- Receipt of medical expenses paid and the insurance of medical expenses.
- My Number Identification of dependents or spouse.
- ▲ Those who are declaring taxation by mail, necessary documents are available at the Tax Office, Tax Section, and Community Centers.

☆Revision of Minimum Wage Code☆

<Minimum Wage of Districts>

Minimum wage code has been revised accordingly and it applies to all workers.

Tochigi Prefecture Minimum Wage Code ¥800 ※Effective from October 1st, 2017

<Specified Minimum Wage> **¥837~¥923 depending on business type** ※Effective from December 31, 2017
